

Crimson Privacy Policy

At Crimson Schools Network, safeguarding the privacy of our visitors is paramount. This Privacy Policy outlines the types of information we collect and use. If you have any questions or need further clarification, please don't hesitate to contact us.

This Privacy Policy applies solely to our online activities and pertains to information shared or collected on the Crimson Schools Network website. It does not extend to information collected offline or through channels other than this website. Crimson Schools Network is not liable for any unauthorized usage, access, or transfer of data by third parties.

Consent

By using our website, you consent to this Privacy Policy and agree to its terms.

Information we collect

Crimson Schools Network collect and store User's Personal Data when the User interacts with Crimson Schools Network website or any of its social media account; contact or meet a Crimson Schools Network's representative; or engage with crimson school in relation to a transaction or any potential transactions.

Crimson School may collect User's Personal Data in writing, by telephone, by e-mail and by online information filled in by the User on Crimson Schools Network website or by filling in forms shared by Crimson. Crimson may receive information from advertisement forms, google ad words, third parties who collect Personal Data from the User and share with Crimson for background verification about the User or their business.

How we use your information

We use the information we collect in various ways, including to:

- Provide, operate, and maintain our website
- Improve, personalize, and expand our website
- Understand and analyze how you use our website
- Develop new products, services, features, and functionality
- Communicate with you, either directly or through one of our partners, including for customer service, to provide you with updates and other information relating to the website, and for marketing and promotional purposes
- Send you invitations, presentations, and updates via emails
- Find and prevent fraud
- For research, to carry out necessary contracts, to comply with regulatory and legal obligations

Log Files

Crimson Schools Network follows a standard procedure of using log files. These files log visitors when they visit websites. Most hosting companies do this and a part of hosting services' analytics. The information collected by log files include internet protocol (IP) addresses, browser type, Internet Service Provider (ISP), date and time stamp, referring/exit pages, and the number of clicks. These are not linked to any information that is personally identifiable. The purpose of the information is for analyzing trends, administering the site, tracking users' movement on the website, and gathering demographic information.

Third Party Consent

Where the User submit its Personal Data on behalf of another person, the User confirms that they have made that person aware of how Crimson Schools Network may collect, use, disclose, transfer and process their Personal Data, the reason of collection, manner of contacting Crimson Schools Network, and all the terms of this Privacy Policy. Links to other Websites

Crimson Schools Network website may provide links to other websites or social media accounts for the User's convenience and information. These websites and/ or social media accounts may operate independently and may not be under the direct control of Crimson Schools Network. Such linked websites and/ or social media accounts may have their own privacy policies and are suggested to be reviewed by the User. To the extent that any linked websites and/ or social media accounts are not under the control of Crimson Schools Network, Crimson Schools Network shall not be responsible for the contents, use of the websites and/ or social media accounts, or the privacy practices of such websites and or social media accounts.

Confidentiality & Security

Crimson Schools Network will take all steps necessary to:

- Protect all Personal Data collected from the User;
- Ensure that the Personal Data collected by Crimson Schools Network remains confidential and secure; and
- Ensure that User's personal privacy is respected.

All data will be stored in physical or electronic form on the servers of Crimson Schools Network and at various physical locations. Crimson Schools Network will maintain physical, electronic and procedural safeguards to protect the User's Personal Data from misuse, unauthorised access or disclosure, and loss or corruption by computer viruses and other sources of harm.

Crimson Schools Network maintains administrative, technical and physical safeguards designed to protect Personal Data against accidental, unlawful or unauthorized use, access, disclosure, alteration, loss, or destruction.

Cookies and Web Beacons

Crimson Schools Network uses cookies to enhance user experience by storing preferences and analyzing website traffic. Cookies allow us to customize content based on browser type and other user-specific information.
